
Dear Connie:

This is simply to let you know, with the Tulane censure now removed, that I have written again to Father Wildes. I have noted that UNO and Loyola are the only remaining post-Katrina censures, that only three cases of litigating dismissed professors remain to be resolved, and that settling them without going through formal trials would seem to be to everyone's advantage. Once the cases are behind us, I wrote, we can discuss what else has to be done to bring the censure to a close. If and when we get to that point, I shall certainly want to hear from the AAUP chapter.
